Yearly report

Here is a report of the work we have done between July 2017 and July 2018.

Fundraising & Awareness-raising

From July 2017

- July 11 Stop Funding Hate protest at Marks and Spencer's, Aberystwyth - part of a national campaign to ask M&S to stop advertising in the Daily Mail newspaper.
- July 19: Fundraising and awareness raising at the Machynlleth Wednesday Market
- July 31 August 2: Redress the Balance at El Sueno Existe Festival putting the Fun into Fundraising through MWRA's lavish dressing-up tent.
- September 8-11: Tent clean up at Festival no 6
- October 21: MWRA's first birthday celebration at Pantperthog Village hall, with information about our activities and discussion about how people would like to get involved
- November 10: Stall at Magic Lantern's Watch Africa film festival
- November 21- Stand at Aber Food Surplus event in aid of Help Refugees.
- November 23: Machynlleth officially granted 'Town of Sanctuary' status
- November 24: Ffilm and Ffalaffel 'Terrafirma', Pantperthog village hall. Film about an Italian fisherman and his family caught between the law of the land and the law of the sea when he helps a group of migrants rescued from an overburdened raft. Raised £298

- November 28: Members of Mid Wales Refugee Action met with Montgomeryshire MP Glyn Davies at the Sanctuary in Parliament event to campaign for a more humane asylum system.
- November 18: MWRA members attend demonstration at Yarlswood detention centre to call for an end to the indefinite imprisonment without trial of migrants, including chidren.

- December Lobbying of Calais prefecture to ask them to provide emergency accommodation for migrants sleeping rough in winter conditions.

With funds raised we have...

- Funded six volunteer visits to France and Serbia, providing 60 days of voluntary work directly assisting refugees and grass roots organisations in Northern France and in Serbia, where hundreds of people are living without adequate food, shelter or access to water or services.
- These trips include the delivery of essential donations and the ability to identify urgent financial needs and enable calls for financial donations from MWRA funds raised.
- July 2017 £200 to Kesha Niya, who supply food and hot meals to refugees on the French / Italian border
- August 2017 £666 to Kesha Niya to enable them to repair their van.
- September 2017 £500 Dunkirk ground support van
- November 2017 January 2018 £325 MWRA sponsors a series of Women's only Tai Chi classes in Aberystwyth to support Syrian women living in Aberystwyth and to promote cross-cultural friendships.
- February 2018 £188 donation to support refugee safe travel through Serbia.
- February 2018 £264 Calais wood yard
- February 2018 £100 Calais hospital visits & transportation
- February 2018 £750 to Utopia 56 who distribute food and clothing in Dunkirk and Calais and provide police surveillance to try and protect refugees from state violence and intimidation for one week running costs.
- February 2018 £143.85 Sanctuary day visit for resettled Syrians living in Newtown and Aberystwyth
- February 2018 £100 Dunkirk Women's Centre, providing support and resources for women and children
- March 2018 £205 donation to Utopia 56

Volunteering & Deliveries

- 31 July 2017: delivery of essential donations by member en route through Calais.
- 23 September 2017: one day volunteering at Calais kitchen by members returning through Calais.
- 26 30 October 2017: 3 volunteers to Calais with donations including clippers for a mobile barber, volunteering in the kitchens, wood yard, distribution and sorting of donations.
- 9 14 November 2017: 2 volunteers o Calais with car full of donations for L'auberge des Migrants and culture project promoting sporting activities in Calais, volunteering in the kitchens, wood yard, distribution and sorting of donations.
- 2-8 December 2017 2 volunteers to Calais
- 21 29 December 2017: 2 volunteers to Serbia to volunteer with BelgrAID and learn more about the refugee situation on the edges of the European Community borders.
- 13-18 February 2018: 2 volunteers to Calais and help in hospitals emotionally supporting injured people and providing transport. In the wood yard enabling purchasing of essentials for the distribution of firewood in extreme cold and volunteering in the kitchens and distribution and sorting of donations. Enable MWRA donation to

- Utopia 56 of one weeks running costs to help them through gap in access to finances,
- 25 31 March 2018: 3 volunteers to Calais, continue with support for wood yard, getting involved in infrastructure support for distribution and data recording, volunteering in the kitchens, distribution and sorting of donations.
- 26 May 2 June 2018 : 1 volunteer to Calais presenting new software for more efficient infrastructure processes for recording distribution data, distribution of food and clothes, assisting with transportation and support for detained refugees.
